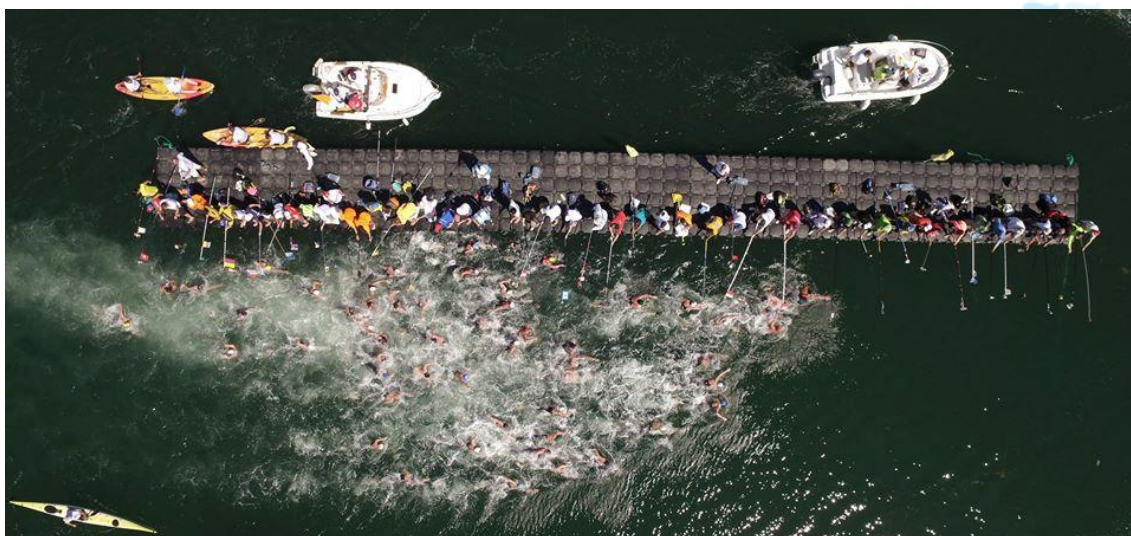




## INTRODUCTION

All National Teams registration, entries and accommodation will be done, by filling all the forms provided with the information bulletin.

### FINAL ENTRIES & ACCREDITATIONS (Deadline 09<sup>th</sup> June 2025)

### PROTOCOL

All costumes, swimwear and technology shall be in accordance with World Aquatics Open Water Swimming - Swimwear & Technology rules and European Aquatics General Event Rules E.19.

## TRAINING SCHEDULE

The official period of stay for team delegations will be from June 16 to June 22, 2025. Pre-competition training will take place at “Complexo Municipal de Piscinas das Manteigadas”, 50m swimming pool. Ocean training will also be a possibility on the afternoons. Team Leaders, at arrival, will choose which days they will attend the ocean training sessions.

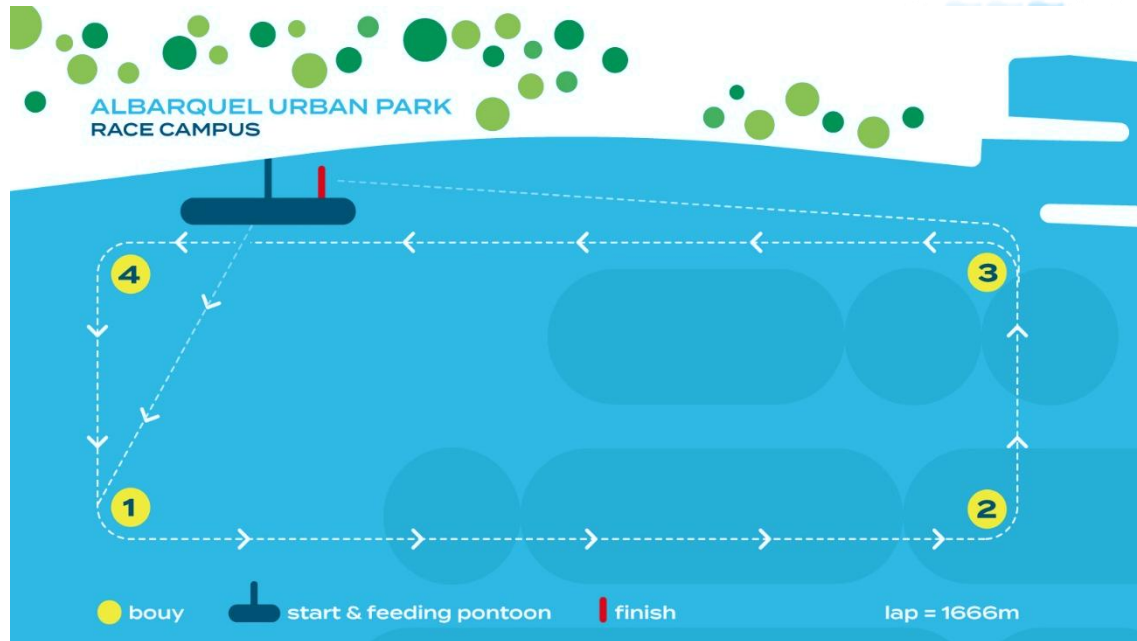

Award ceremonies will take place at the competition venue, immediately after the race. All announcements, instructions, and commands during the event will be in English.

## COURSE INFORMATION

The Competition will be organized on a rectangular shape with 4 main buoys, and each lap will have: 5k – 1.66m (3 laps); 7.5k - 1.5k (5 laps); 10k – 1.66k (6 laps); 5k Mixed Relay - 1.5k each lap; 3k Knockout – 1.5k + 1k + 0.5k.



The details on this event will be communicated in the Technical Meeting.

## WEATHER INFORMATION



The average air & water temperatures in Setubal for the month of June are:

The average minimum temperature (usually the minimum temperature is noted during the night) in Setúbal in June is 17.0°C (62.6°F). June is a dry month with an average of 16mm (0.6in) rain. It rains on average a total of 5 days. The average maximum daytime temperature lies



around 26.0°C (78.8°F). If you enjoy looking at a blue sky and love the sun then this is a great time to go to Setúbal with 301 hours of sun.

**VISA REQUIREMENTS**

All visitors to Setubal, Portugal should have a valid visa for their entry and stay in the country. The Portuguese Swimming Federation will facilitate an entry visa to Portugal for all participants and coordinate all the required procedures upon receipt of (a) electronic copies of a valid passport (at least for 6 months from the entry date), (b) date of arrival and (c) country of residence. All information should reach the Portuguese Swimming Federation no later than April 16<sup>th</sup> 2025.
